The committee continues to focus on the Wooly Adelgid or HWA, with the intention of increasing peoples' awareness and identification of this invasive insect. A zoom meeting was held on 8/17/20, to present a documentary film, titled, **The Hemlock Wooly Adelgid - A film about the loss of an Ecosystem,** by Chris Foito. The HWA is an invasive forest insect that is a serious threat to the native Eastern Hemlock trees in the eastern U.S. It has recently been found on Eastern Hemlock Trees in the Lake George area. The concern is that the HWA will eventually come to the Adirondacks, and destroy mass stands of hemlocks. The HWA insect has the potential to destroy entire hemlock forests. A few chemical treatments and biological predators of the HWA have been found that effectively kill the insects, however, they need to be discovered on the trees early. The film shows the HWA Insects and how they appear on the needles of a hemlock tree, very clearly, and excellent information is shared by the presenters. The message is that people need to learn NOW, how to identify the HWA and be proactive in inspecting their hemlocks regularly.
